DECISION

The Regional Hygiene Station of the South Bohemian Region based in České Budějovice (hereinafter "KHS" or the "administrative authority") as the competent public and local authority for the protection of public health pursuant to § 82 par. 1, 2, subparagraph a) of Act no. 258/2000 Coll., on the protection of public health and the amendment of certain related Acts, as amended (hereinafter "Act no. 258/2000 Coll."), and § 11 par. 1 subparagraph a) of Act no. 500/2004 Coll., Code of Administrative Procedure, as amended (hereinafter the "Code of Administrative Procedure"), has decided on the application pursuant to § 15 par. 2 of Act no. 258/2000 Coll. as follows:

Health care service provider SochORL s.r.o., registered office at Počernická 512/58, Malešice, 108 00 Prague 10, CRN 02590069, applied to KHS on 5 March 2021 to approve a change in the rules of operation: outpatient ENT clinic- amendment for online testing - antigen saliva test, compiled on: 5 March 2021, place of provision of health care services: Jungmannova 29/1, Vnitřní Město, 397 01 Písek, method of health care: outpatient, field of health care - otorhinolaryngology and head and neck surgery.

(hereinafter the "rules of operation"), which were approved by a decision of the Regional Hygiene Station of the South Bohemian Region based in České Budějovice on 6 April 2017 under ref. no. KHSJC 10410/2017/EPID PI-ST, file no. S-KHSJC 08460/2017.

The change in the rules of operation, consisting in an amendment for online saliva antigen tests for SARS-CoV-2 is approved by the Regional Hygiene Station of the South Bohemian Region based in České Budějovice

on 8 March 2021.

Justification:

The presented rules of operation meet the hygiene conditions for the operation of a health care facility as defined in § 15 par. 1 and 2 of Act no. 258/2000 Coll. With regard to this fact, the regional hygiene station approved the application, therefore permitting the proposed rules of operation.

Pursuant to § 100 of Act no. 258/2000 Coll., the person who wrote the rules of operation must make sure that his employees and other persons working at his workplaces read them, as well as ensure that they are adhered to.

Extension of the rules of operation of SochORL s.r.o., which was approved on 6 April 2017

The extension concerns "online testing - antigen saliva tests with NewGene tests.

The online antigen collection site will meet all legal requirements arising from Measures, the Law and Decree no. 99/2021 Coll., on requirements for the minimum amount of health care workers, as amended.

The online testing will take place as follows: the tested person will purchase the NewGene test via the e-shop directly in the Online System (or in the pharmacy network); then, this individual will log in to the Online System, where he will register for Online Testing; a test will be performed to determine the presence of the SARS CoV-2 virus antigen using the NewGene test in the tested person's home environment online via videoconference in the Online System with a health care professional who will assist in the Online Testing; in the event of a positive NewGene test result, the locally competent public health authority will be notified that the test subject has been tested with a positive result; according to the methodological communication of the waste department of the Ministry of the Environment file no. MZP/2021/z, antigen tests intended for self-testing of persons should be classified as and disposed of as mixed municipal waste 20 03 01; tests with a positive result should be placed in a separate plastic bag and then disposed of.

It is for this reason that we believe it is not necessary for a health care professional to be present, which also corresponds with the information provided in the NewGene test documentation. Despite this advantage, however, we believe the assistance of a health care professional is essential to perform the test in accordance with the instructions, which is why a health care professional would be present via videoconference. A high standard of personal data protection will be set during the Online Testing, and compliance with all regulations relating to personal data protection and the provision of health services will be ensured.

Online Testing will be performed during the office hours of the SochORL clinic as well as outside office hours, depending on the current epidemiological situation, and on weekends as needed.
